*May these acknowledgements renew in us our commitment to persist in anti-racism and anti-oppression practices.*

- **CALLS TO THE CHURCH: EVENTS AND PROGRAMS FOR EDUCATION**

in preparation for the visit of **The Honourable Senator Murray Sinclair**, Diane MJ, Kathy D, Thérèse S met with Sara Stratton (GC Staff), and the following tentative plans for sessions to prepare people for the upcoming event with Justice Sinclair:

**Main Event:**

WHAT: UCC, Residential Schools and TRC 101

An Introduction or Refresher to key events and issues related to the United Church of Canada's call to right relations between Indigenous and Non-Indigenous peoples.

WHEN: Two offerings, one daytime and one evening. Tentative dates (dates to be confirmed, Indigenous Elder hopefully to be part of each)

Thursday April 29, morning

Wednesday May 5, evening

**Experiential Events:**

Tentative pending availability of facilitators, etc., hoped to precede the main event mentioned above:

- KAIROS Blanket Exercise – Virtual

- Woodland Centre tour of Mohawk Institute

Then, following the event with Justice Sinclair on May 28<sup>th</sup>, another event for developing concrete Action Plan. Yet to be planned.

- **GUARANTEED LIVABLE INCOME (GLI):**

Light a Candle on April 8, vigil to support the guaranteed livable income movement: This is primarily a virtual vigil. People are being asked to light a candle, take a picture and post it to social media, send it to the Prime Minister, Minister of Finance, local MP, news outlets. Follow up with email or phone call.

There will be small in-person vigils held at select locations, with designated individuals only. The public is NOT invited to attend these, to ensure all restrictions on gatherings are upheld.

- **ORIENTATION**

At this time, I am, with significant guidance, support and input from the staff team, orienting myself to the work of the region related to my two portfolios of Right Relations and Social Justice and the online office technology.

There is lots of information in here for the United Church Camps to use.  
Some brief highlights:  
UCC Camps saw a 99% decrease in the number of campers from 2019  
UCC Camps reported a \$6.28 million loss in revenue in 2020  
45 unique UCC sites responded to the survey  
64% of our camps have no full-time staff  
100% of our camp directors responding were white – 38% were male, 62% were female  
71% of our camps had no onsite guests or programming in 2020  
40% of our camps saw lower donations than in 2019

**Diane Matheson-Jimenez, Minister for Social Justice:**

- **March 5, 2021** folks from across the country met to talk about the crisis in LTC facilities. Engaging in a plenary session, we heard from Steven Staples of the Canadian Health Coalition. Steven is working on a national day of action at the end of April and will channel information to interested parties through me. In smaller regional groups, we began networking and sharing resources.

The next step will be to another gathering but this time we will divide into interest groups based on how we feel called to respond to the crisis.
